

Cookie Policy - Charles McCarthy Insurances Limited T/A Simply Insure

Our Cookie Policy explains what cookies are, how we use cookies, how third parties we may partner with may use cookies on our website, your choices regarding cookies and further information about cookies.

A cookie is a small piece of data that may be stored on your computer or mobile device. It allows a website “remember” your actions or preferences over a length of time.

By continuing to browse the site, you are agreeing to the use of our cookies unless you choose to not accept cookies within your browser settings.

Cookies used on website

The following categories describe the range of cookies that can be used during your visit to our website.

1. Remembering your settings and your preferences

We use cookies to store preferences and settings from your visit. This includes the cookie used to check whether you have viewed our cookie banner so we won't show it to you again. We use cookies to store the language preference and accessibility preferences on our website.

2. Anti-forgery

We use cookies to make sure that forms on our website, such as the ‘Contact Us Form’ are not used in the wrong way, for example as part of a cyber-attack.

3. Measuring website usage (Google Analytics)

We use Google Analytics to collect information about how people use this website. Google Analytics stores information about what pages you visit, how long you are on the website, how you got here and what you click on. We do not collect or store your personal information (e.g. your name or address) so this information cannot be used to identify who you are.

4. Third party services and social networks

Simply Insure maintains social network accounts such as on Facebook, Twitter and LinkedIn. We may embed widgets from these networks to provide follow buttons, like boxes and stream embeds.

This may result in cookies being set by these networks and third parties while using our website.

What are your choices regarding cookies?

Within your browser you can choose whether you wish to accept cookies or not. Your browser will offer you the choice to accept, refuse or delete cookies at all times, or those

from providers that website owners use ("third party cookies"), or those from specific websites.
